### The Angel of the Battlefield

The world can never forget the name Florence Nightingale. She devoted her life to\* the care of dying people, and thanks to her efforts, hospitals all over the world have been improved.

Florence was born in 1820, and she was the daughter of rich British parents. As her parents often held parties, her home was always full of visitors, but Florence was more interested in taking care of the visitors' children than in the parties themselves.

When she was a little girl, she liked playing with her dolls, and she pretended\* to be a nurse taking care of sick dolls. One day she saved the life of a dog with broken legs. At the age of 16, she decided to devote her life to serving sick people in hospitals. However, Florence's parents opposed\* this decision, because the hospitals at that time were ugly, dirty, and dangerous. In spite of\* their opposition, she became a nurse. She visited hospitals all over Europe and soon she became the head of a group of nurses in a London hospital.

Soon after that, war broke out\* in Russia. Thousands of British soldiers were killed in the battle. Thousands more were wounded and dying. There were no nurses there, so Florence gathered a group of 38 young ladies and sailed for Russia to take care of these wounded and dying soldiers. When she arrived, she saw wounded people on the floors in dirty old buildings. There were no beds. There were few blankets. There was no medicine\*. There was little food. It was a shocking situation.

Miss Nightingale was shocked at what she saw, but soon she began to improve the situation. She cleaned the buildings, organized\* the nurses, managed to get food, blankets and medicine, and by her love and devotion comforted\* suffering and dying people. She was called "the angel of the battlefield."

Not only the ordinary people but Queen Victoria herself honored\* Florence Nightingale for what she had done. And today the whole world honors "the angel of the battlefield."
